Felgate (palisaded altar tomb) John son of John and Elizabeth Felgate heretofore of this parish d 24 Mar 1781 aged 68, Sarah his wife d 12 Mar 1808 aged 88; Elizabeth their daughter d 12 Jun 1760 aged 12; John Felgate, gentleman son of the above John and Sarah Felgate died at Bawdsey in this County 1 Dec 1825 aged 72; Sarah his wife daughter of William Whincopp Esq late of Bredfield in this County

d 2 Dec 1797 aged 31; John their infant child interred 6 Aug 1787

Langley (grave described as being by East wall of porch) Thomas and Jane his wife. She died 13 Sep 1783 aged 73. He died 14 Sept 1783 aged 77, 'Their lives were one contented scene of conjugal affection and in their Death were hardly divided.' William their son, d 27 Jan 1766 aged 16; Jane their daughter May 1795 aged 55.
