From Rev'd Ann:

We are not alone. I don't mean this in the *'there are aliens out there somewhere'* way, but that

as humans we belong to humanity—to society, community and family. As Christians we also believe that we belong to the body of Christ here on earth – the church.

This season in the church is called **Kingdom Season** and it is a season of remembering and of belonging. It begins on 1st November with the celebration of All Saints, reminding us of the body of men and women who lived and died for their faith, and those more familiar saints who have helped, supported and nourished us along the way. It is a reminder that God's grace is available to us through others in both ordinary circumstances as well as extraordinary crises. In other words, in all seasons of human life.

Then we have the more intimate Commemoration of the Faithful Departed – All Souls—where we remember with thanks those we have known personally who have shaped our lives.

Then on Remembrance Sunday we continue to explore the theme of memory as we confront issues of war and peace, loss and sacrifice.



Of course, when we see the state of the world today we might wonder how any of this is relevant. But I think that remembering, both individually and collectively, is important.

Memories can be life-giving and sustaining but they can also be painful and lifesapping. If we allow them to overwhelm us or to completely cloud our judgement of the present, then a self-perpetuating cycle of pain, hatred and division ensues, as we are seeing only too tragically today in many parts of the world.

Finally, we end the season, with the Feast of Christ the King. The church year, which begins again the following Sunday, Advent Sunday, begins and ends with hope. Hope of the coming of the Messiah, of light in the darkness and, for the church, the hope of Christ's universal sovereignty. (continued on p 2)
