Annual Report of Kettleburgh Green Trust

Last year we were successful in getting a National lottery grant of £7700. The application was made to buy new play equipment and also replace some of the tables and benches which had been pointed out by Rospa as in need of repair or replacement.

We used a company in Ipswich - Realise Futures who use reclaimed plastics to make their products. This is much more durable and long lasting than wood.

We purchased a train for the children's area and two new tables with integrated seating and a bench.

The repair to one of the paths on the Green is still outstanding but hopefully will be rectified soon.

This year we raised £1403 from the Village Green Lottery .

The clothes bank in the Chequers realised $\pounds 156$. This was divided equally with the Village Hall and the Church each receiving $\pounds 52$

Easy Fund raising realised £100.70

Amazon realised £32.41

This pays the annual maintenance bill and the insurance The annual inspection by Rospa did not highlight any worrying problems.

We are very grateful to Katie Harris Hartley for her donation which has paid for new dog bins for the Green. I am extremely grateful to my fellow Trustees for their continuing help and support.

The Green continues to be a much used asset to the Village.
