Points raised: There has been no material change to affect the reasoning for the original condition. Other wedding venues locally all have the same midnight closing time. Temporary Event Notices would be available on top of the 30 events applied for under this application. There are a limited number allowable, they are expensive to apply for and require a public notice so parishioners have the chance to object. The venue has not been open through the summer yet so locals cannot judge what disturbance may be caused. The re was support for the local business. The public in attendance were generally opposed to the extension but other opinions reported included a preference of a few for the 2am time and some who didn't think any noise would have much effect. The Council will object on the grounds of the first point above as it was considered that amenity and the protection of the local environment could be adversely affected by the proposed later closing time. 14.
